To increase supply chain efficiencies, the company is consolidating two separate distribution centers and will use this facility to assemble and distribute packaging materials to its customers located across the Western United States. This facility will also be used by Paramount Can's sister company. Paramount Global Services, Inc., a logistics and supply chain management company.
