Tecogen subsidiary sells heat pumps to Florida biomedical research facility

Ilios Dynamics, a subsidiary of Waltham-based energy systems company Tecogen Inc. (Nasdaq: TGEN), said Thursday that it sold seven of its natural gas enginedriven heat pumps to a biomedical research facility in Florida.

The company said the pumps will be providing hot water at over twice the efficiency of the existing boiler plant.

Steve Lafaille, product manager at Ilios, said he could not name the facility in Florida or name the location, but it marks a significant step for the company as it expands its products into the pharmaceutical and lab markets. The company recently installed one of its systems at a large pharmaceutical company in Ireland, Lafaille said.
