

Olympics Beats the Final Frontier for Social Mentions

LONDON -- (Marketwire) -- 08/14/12 -- (NYSE: AMD) -- With 54,455,926 social mentions through the closing ceremonies, the Olympics dominated space explorer Mars Curiosity and other major world news over the last couple of weeks, as evidenced by the amount of social shares according to data from social sharing platform AddThis, the world's largest social sharing platform.
