The Work Number is fully compliant with the federal Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), and as such requires that:

- All verifier clients are credentialed
- A permissible purpose be provided for every verification request
- The employee-consumer has the ability to view their data file
- The employee-consumer has the ability to dispute data errors

The Work Number goes beyond FCRA, however, requiring not only permissible purpose but also consumer consent for the release of income or salary information.
