Congresswoman Ann Wagner and Equifax senior financial officer, Ken Marshall cut the ribbon at the new Equifax Earth City facility on April 24, 2014.

With the opening of the Rider Trail facility, St. Louis is the second-largest employee location in the Equifax portfolio with 1,250 full-time employees and contractors in the area, accounting for 20 percent of the Equifax U.S. workforce and nearly 60 percent of the Workforce Solutions division. The expansion is part of a larger global Equifax initiative, known as Score 850, designed to improve collaboration and drive performance through innovative and flexible workspaces that provide access to advanced technology.
