The aircraft benefits from an industry-leading 50 minutes 'dry-run' capability on the main gearbox, exceeding current certification standards and offering unmatched safety and reliability for long-range operations. Era took delivery of an additional two AW189 helicopters in 2016, increasing the Company's AgustaWestland fleet to over 60 helicopters including four AW189s.

"Showcasing the versatile AW189 currently in service with Era, the world's largest civilian operator of AgustaWestland helicopters, allows us to further display the aircraft's adaptability in support of a variety of mission profiles to key decision makers across the helicopter industry," added Daniele Romiti, Managing Director of Leonardo Helicopters. The dedicated aircraft feature complete Advanced Life Support (ALS) medical care packages, including critical care, fluid resuscitation, advanced airway, pain management and cardiac monitoring, providing unparalleled medical response capabilities. Era was the first emergency flight services provider to configure the AW139 for full SAR mission capabilities.
