






#### Median Kiosk Transaction Size Trend (\$USD)






- Total revenue of \$179M for Q3-2023 improved as compared to Q3-2022, up +3% YoY – the improvement was largely driven by increased median transaction size






# Financial Update – Balance Sheet



- The total Cash and Cash Equivalents decrease from the year ended 2022 was largely driven by the refinancing of the Company's term loan facility, continued paydown of finance leases, and distributions associated with the closing of the Company's business combination
- Positive operating cash flow of \$33M was offset by \$39M in cash expenditures from financing, mainly related to the aforementioned items.



Moreover, we have included Adjusted EBITDA in this Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q because it is a key measurement used internally by management to make operating decisions, including those related to operating expenses, evaluate performance and perform strategic and financial planning.
