Y FEST will be held at the Cape Cod Melody Tent, presenting four national Christian music recording artists, including three-time GRAMMY-winning artist Jars of Clay. Y FEST 2003 kicks off July 1 with the O.C. Supertones and continues every other Tuesday night of the summer. Other headliners include Audio Adrenaline and Ten Shekel Shirt. Last year, over 6,000 people attended Y FEST.

This event is intended to be a fun, positive, and alcohol-free event for local young people. Each night will feature a national recording artist and a talented and challenging guest speaker. Mountain bikes and other prizes will be given away. Y FEST was conceived and organized by a group of young adults and teens on Cape Cod concerned about local youth.

Y FEST is sponsorship driven and completely volunteer run. Corporate, church, and individual donors have contributed over \$40,000 so far this year, allowing Y FEST to offer low ticket prices, including a limited supply of \$12 outreach tickets to those who commit to bringing a friend.
