ABOUT TRACE ADKINS: Trace Adkins' trademark baritone has powered countless hits to the top of the charts and turned albums into Platinum plaques, selling over 10 million albums, cumulatively. His hit list includes "(This Ain't) No Thinkin' Thing," "You're Gonna Miss This," "Ladies Love Country Boys," "Songs About Me," "Honky Tonk Badonkadonk," "I Left Something Turned On At Home," "Every Light In The House," "Hillbilly Bone (Blake Shelton and Trace Adkins)," "The Rest Of Mine," "Hot Mama," "I'm Tryin'," "Just Fishin'," "Then They Do," "Chrome," and "More."

The Grammy-nominated member of the Grand Ole Opry is a television personality, actor, author, spokesman for the Wounded Warrior Program, the American Red Cross and has performed seven USO Tours.

McConaughey), he developed and hosted GAC's "Great American Heroes" honoring everyday Americans doing great things and he has hosted the American Country Awards on FOX for three consecutive years.

In 2011, Trace's album, *Proud To Be Here* debuted atop the Billboard Country Chart with the Top Ten hit, "Just Fishin'." His eleventh studio album, *Love Will...* debuts May 14, 2013.

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
