Privacy Notice - Your Personal Data

By and submitting a job application, you are providing us with your personal data. These terms set out the way in which that personal data will be used and processed by Adaptimmune.

What is personal data?

Who is responsible for looking after my personal data?

What will we use your personal data for?

- Your personal data will be used as reasonably necessary to assess and progress your application for

 individuals within Adaptimmune who are responsible for or involved in taking a decision on whether

Can I withdraw my personal information?

You can request that we cease processing your personal information at any time. If you request that we cease processing your personal information, we will cease processing and delete your personal information. However we may archive part or all of your Personal Information for the purpose of complying with any laws, regulations or other legal actions that may impose such an obligation on Adaptimmune.

How long will you retain my personal information?

Your Personal Information will be maintained in our database for a maximum period of twelve (12) months from your most recent update, or a longer or shorter period if required by local law. Additionally, in some countries, regulatory requirements exist that mandate the retention of data for a specific period of time if an individual is under consideration for a particular opening.
