Update April 15, 2022 EL Paso TX Border Update

The El Paso Field Office has de-activated a business resumption contingency plan due to significant reduction in commercial truck wait times at the Ysleta Bridge of the Americas, and Santa Teresa commercial port of entry. With tensions easing and inspections ending, commercial traffic crossings are continuing and delays are being reduced.

Agreement with MX local officials and TX governor on Wednesday resulted in easing tensions and blockades on the MX border side. Texas Department of Public Safety enhanced inspections ended late Thursday, April 14th. City of Juarez and El Paso Field Trade office in collaboration and agreement with local ports and trades and Agencia Nacional de Aduanas de Mexico to modify additional commercial cargo hours of operation for today April 15th and Saturday April 16th.

All ports of entry will resume normal hours of operation on Monday April 18th. We expect during the week to see resumed "normal" border crossing times.
